Registration and Precautions:

- 1. Once accepted, students must participate in all training courses and activities, no single choice available.
- 2. Students with the hours of attendance more than 90% shall be given a training certificate of completion.
- 3. Camp Fee is non-refundable. The following year students shall have completed more than 90 percent of study courses, and after training, having participated in at least 3 items of the follow-up empowerment program by the end of August.
- 4. If students unable to participate in the training for some reason shall submit the application 20 days before the class starts (including the date of start) 20 days before the application; otherwise, the camp fee will not be returned.
- 5. Registration is on rolling basis. The camp is limited to 50 new students and 36 TAs. Once reach the maximum enrollment, the registration will be ended.
